Frenquently Asked Questions

Q.) Does registration have to be paid all at once?

A.) No it doesn't, we are willing to work with you and take payments. But money owed to the league has to be paid prior to uiform dispersment, or your child will not reiceve theirs until it is paid in full.

Q.) My child is going into the 7th grade; can I register him and/or her?

A.) We don't register 7th graders because they can play in middle school.

Q.) Can anyone work concessions?

A.) Each team is asked to provide 2 concession workers for a two-hour shift on their given day. If they are 16 years of age they can work the front, and they must be 18 years of age to work the grill.

Q.) If I have a player playing football on a team, can my daughter cheer for that same team?

A.) Yes, we keep siblings together unless you request them not to.

Q.) Do we have to supply Helmets and shoulder pads ourselves?

A.) No, the league has helmets and shoulders to be issued out during registration while supplies last.

Q.) How do I become a coach or assistant?

A.) You will have to complete a background check and if your background check comes back clear, then you can coach a team if one is vacant or help an existing coach.

Q.) What does the registration fee cover?

A.) Football registration fee covers the cost of the game jersey, usage of helmet and shoulder pads (while supplies last). Cheer registration fee covers uniform (shell,skirt, bloomers and pom-poms). Registration fees also cover operating costs (i.e field rental, utilities and refferes.)

Q.) Will there be other expenses?

A.) Players are responsible for purchasing other uniform items such as mouthguards, pants, cleats, and chin strap. Cheer is responsible for purchasing socks, shoes, and bows.

Q.) When does the season begin and end?

A.) The first scrimmage is historically the middle of September and Super Bowl is the weekend before Thanksgiving.

Q.) When does practice start, what days and times?

A.) Practice will begin after registration is closed and the draft for each league is completed. Dates and times are up to the Head Coach of the team.

Q.) Does it cost to get into the games?

A.) The League doesn't charge gates fees, except at Super Bowl.
